

4-H POULTRY CHAIN AGREEMENT 2020

The undersigned 4-H club member and his/her parent(s) agree to accept twentyfive or twelve baby chicks through the Lincoln County 4-H Poultry Chain Activity under the following conditions and responsibilities:

- 1. There is not a fee collected to be a part of the Lincoln County Poultry Chain.
- 2. The chicks will be paid for by each 4-H club member by returning six pullets to the Show and Sale in September at the Lincoln County Fair.
- 3. Being a livestock project some loss can be expected (3 to 4 chicks) if you loss more than the expected you must notify the 4-H office as soon as possible so adjustments can be made.
- 4. Pullets returned by the 4-H club member will be <u>shown</u> and <u>sold</u> at our Poultry Show & Sale. Each 4-H club member may receive some prize money in accordance with the placing his pullets receive at this show from the official judge(s). On this same day the pullets returned by each 4-H club member will be sold at this Sale, and the proceeds earned will be placed back into the 4-H Poultry Fund to give other boys and girls the same opportunity that you had, to receive baby chicks the next year. If a 4-H club member fails to bring the designated number of pullets to the sale, he or she will be obligated to buy the pullets themselves at the <u>average</u> sale price.
- 5. Baby chicks will be picked up by 4-H club member at the 4-H Office on the day they arrive.
- 6. The 4-H club member agrees to fulfill his/her responsibilities to <u>feed</u>, <u>water</u>, <u>shelter</u> and to provide their chicks with any other necessary care that their chicks may need to secure them to have a happy home.
- 7. The 4-H club member <u>agrees</u> to <u>show</u> two entries (6 birds) if they received 25 baby chicks or one entry (3 birds) if they receive 12 baby chicks in the Lincoln County Show. You will receive additional information as a reminder concerning this activity at a later time.

This form is due to the Extension Office (4-H Office) by March 2, 2020. By filling out this form, it does not guarantee that you will be selected for the Chick Chain. You will receive a letter in the mail if you are selected by March 20. Chicks are scheduled to arrive in April.
