



## Lincoln County Family and Community Education (fce) Clubs July, 2015, Council Meeting

The Lincoln County fce Council met at 6 o'clock on July 14, 2015. Everyone brought a dish and enjoyed a delicious potluck supper. The meeting was called to order by Council President, Bonnie Pond, at 6:35 p.m.; she also led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Margaret Ellis gave the devotional by reading the poem, "Remember When". The club members present read the club's creed in unison.

The minutes from the April, 2015, meeting were approved as mailed. Treasurer, Carolyn Slayton, was not present due to her husband being in the hospital; Margaret Ellis gave the treasurer's report in her absence. We have \$2,789.23 in available funds.

Roll call was as follows: Boonshill fce Club -1, Dellrose Hotrock fce Club -2, Flintville fce Club -4, McBurg fce Club -1, Mimosa fce Club -2, and Molino fce Club -3, for a total of 13 fce Club members present at the council meeting.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

<u>High School Scholarships</u> – Emily Gordon and Lauren Lee received the two scholarships this year. Margaret Ellis read a thank you note from Lauren Lee.

<u>TAFCE Leadership Retreat (fce camp)</u> – Margaret Ellis gave a brief report on the camp. There was a large turnout for the event and everyone seemed to have enjoyed themselves.

<u>fce Club Name Tags</u> – The UT Extension Office has lanyards available that the fce Clubs can use. Eydie Foster, the office secretary, is willing to design a simple card that can be inserted into the badge holder. Each club should let her know which members are interested in getting a lanyard so that she can get them ready before the next county event.

<u>Storage Room</u> – Several of the fce Club members met to clean out and rearrange the fce Club materials stored down the hall from the Extension Office. Numerous old books and magazines were laid out at the meeting for club members who might want them. Bonnie Pond and her husband carried the leftover materials to the recycle center.

<u>Tabletop Display for the Creative Living Building</u> – A motion was made and seconded to use the fce Club display board that was created earlier this year. Belinda Lance and Carolyn Slayton are working on designing a brochure for handing out at events and activities to help get the fce Club name out into the communities. . Hopefully, these will be available for use during the fair.

## **NEW BUSINES**

<u>Cultural Arts</u> –This year's event will be held Friday, July 31. Items may be entered starting at 8 o'clock; judging will begin at 10:30 a.m. Every club member is encouraged to enter at least one item.

<u>Membership Lists/Club Dues</u> – Membership lists for 2016 and club dues need to be turned in to Carolyn Slayton by September 20.

Club presidents will also be receiving a packet containing the current mailing list used by the UT Extension Office that will need to be updated before the handbooks are printed. Each club member will need to verify their name, address, e-mail address, if applicable, and phone number. They will also be asked to give permission for their information to be printed in the handbook and their picture to appear on the website and to choose whether they would like to be contacted by mail, e-mail or both.

<u>Creative Living Building Update</u> — Ruthie Jeans, this year's Creative Living Building Superintendent, was nice enough to attend the fce Club County Council meeting to discuss her ideas this year's fair. This year there will be two additional entry dates for Dept. 20 (Sewing, Crafts, Canning, Art and Photography): Tuesday and Wednesday, September 8 and 9, from 3:00 p.m. — 7:00 p.m. each day; entries will also be taken on Friday, September 11 from 1:00 p.m. — 7:00 p.m. The theme for this year's fair will be *Burlap and Bling* ~ *A Lincoln County Fair Thing*". Fair entry forms are available at the UT Extension Office.

**Host of Christmas Past** – When the club members cleaned out the store room, several leftover Christmas ornaments from past years were found; a motion was made and carried to sell these ornaments that during this year's *Host of Christmas Past*.

A motion was made and carried that we have the same menu as last year (Southwestern Stew, cornbread muffins, drinks and cookies/brownies. We will discuss this further at the October Council meeting.

Also, a motion was made and carried that the Council purchase a tent and one or two banners that can be used at the *Host of Christmas Past*, as well as, other county-wide events.

<u>Charitable Donations</u> – A motion was made and carried that we donate the same amount as last year to the Imagination Library of Lincoln County.

Also, a motion was made and carried that we make a \$100 donation to the Alzheimer's Association in memory of Eydie Foster's father, Phillip (Nick) Thomason.

<u>National Essay & Artwork Contest for 4<sup>th</sup> Graders</u> – It was decided that we table this until next year when we will hopefully have an UT Extension FCS Agent to help us coordinate this project.


