BIRDFEEDERS & BIRDHOUSES

Birdfeeders and birdhouses can be made from natural materials (wood, bark, etc.) or from recycled materials (drink bottles, aluminum cans, milk jugs, etc.) Do your own work. Both will be judged on usability and creativity. Must be made by the 4-H member. (adult supervision is permitted)



PHOTOGRAPHY

Theme— Landscape or Plant(s)

Tap into your creative side while you capture **Landscape or Plant(s)** through photography! **The photo must be taken by the 4-H member.** Take your best snapshots. Be careful of the light in the background when taking outdoor photos. Select photo that show some imagination! Photos must be 4"x6" matted or mounted on a 5"x7" board or mat. No frames

4-H Scrapbook

A 4-H scrapbook can serve several purposes! Putting together a scrapbook is a fun activity in itself that gets you involved in 4-H! After the scrapbook is completed, it serves as a useful resource for future activities. And of course, the scrapbook will hold many special memories of your 4-H career just like your family photo album.
