Camp sign-up begins Monday, April 27. Applications and payment can be turned in at the Extension Office. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday - Friday. Applications will be taken until May 1 or until all available spots have been filled. Sign-up is on a first-come, first-served basis. This year we are camping with Davidson, Giles, Marshall and Williamson counties.
